At an early age, after giving her life to Christ, she joined the First Baptist Church of Crown Heights in Brooklyn, NY. Upon her retirement of 30 years from the Brooklyn Hospital Center, she moved to Hampton, GA , where she joined her new found church home Zion Baptist Church.

Sister Ada Fulmore joined Faith Chapter No. 92 of Brooklyn, NY in 1971 of International Free and Accepted Modern Masons and Order of the Eastern Star Inc. She was also the President of City District Joint Council No. 8 of Jamaica, NY. For several years, until 2012 , sister Fulmore was dedicated to the organization until the end.

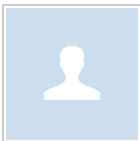
