Bernard Edward Tittle “Tee” was born on July 4, 1958, to the late James A. Tittle and late Julia Mae (Bailey) Tittle. He was born in Atlanta, GA at the famous Grady Hospital (true bonafide “Grady Baby”). Bernard was affectionately known as a child by “Popcorn” and later as a young man as “Tee”. He made his transition on June 2, 2024, with a call time of 9:46 p.m.

Bernard “Tee” was educated in the Atlanta Public School System, and he graduated from D. M. Therrell High School. Later, he continued his education at Morris Brown College in Atlanta, GA. “Tee” was an excellent basketball player. His love for the game and his expert skills led him to be an all-over dominant force. Known by everyone as the “GOAT”. He played for the well-known Pro-Am League, the European Professional Basketball League in the Philippines and in the NBA with the Utah Jazz. Also, was named in ESPN Elite 24 as America’s Playground Legend. He enjoyed coaching the kids and

spending time fishing at the lake.

Bernard was a hard-working man with a loving heart and generous spirit. He loved his family and friends dearly, often returning to visit them with care packages of cash, food and clothing. He worked at Heilig-Meyers as a manager and later at Whole Foods as a Baker Store Manager in Georgia.

In 1996 Bernard met and married the love of his life, Margo Jackson Tittle. Together they worked hard to build and seize the opportunity to start "Tittle's Elite Security" in 1998. Later acquiring private security contracts for Family Feud, Judge Steve Harvey and many more.

Bernard will be missed by his loving wife, Margo Tittle; daughters, Aja Barnes-Tittle and India Bridgeforth (Chris); grandson, Carmelo Bridgeforth; five sisters, Cherran Tittle, Cynthia Tittle (Louis), Julia Williamson (Michael{deceased}), Janice Manuel (John) and Stephanie Tittle; brother, James Tittle; a host of nephews, Alfred Tittle (Angela) who was like a brother, cousins other relatives and friends.

He was preceded in death by his father, James Tittle; mother, Julia Tittle; sister, Barbara (Tittle) Brown and brother, Kenneth Tittle.

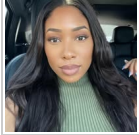
