Minister Gloria D. Mormon was born on March 20, 1961, to Charlene White in Collins, Mississippi. She attended school in Prentiss, Mississippi and graduated from Prentiss High School. Gloria joined the United States Army in July, 1979 where she served for four years. On September 3, 1983, she married the love of her life, Minister Mitchell Mormon in Fort Riley, Kansas and they recently celebrated their 40th wedding anniversary. Three beautiful children, two boys and one girl, were born to this union.

In 1985, Gloria and Mitchell were stationed in Bad Kissingen, Germany where she served as a secretary in the Military Aid Station until 1993. When they completed their duty in Germany, they moved to Fort Hood, Texas from 1993-1994, where they retired from the military. After retirement, they moved to Las Cruces, New Mexico where they resided for eleven (11) years. While in New Mexico, she worked as a Contractor. The family moved to Georgia in 2006 and Gloria was employed with the Internal Revenue Service as a Tax Examiner until retiring in 2017.

Gloria gave her life to Christ in Bad Kissingen, Germany at the New Jerusalem Church of God in Christ. She served as Sunday school teacher, usher, choir member and Jurisdictional Hospitality president until 1993. When they moved to Las Cruces, New Mexico, she became a member of New Life Church of God in Christ where she served as church secretary. In 2006, they

moved to Georgia, and in 2008, joined Higher Living Christian Church where she served as new member intake coordinator. In 2013, she joined Tabernacle of Praise Church International under the leadership of Pastors Timothy J. and Shunnae' McBride and was ordained as Minister in 2015. She served faithfully at the McDonough and Jonesboro Campuses and she and her husband, Minister Mitchell served as Lead Ministers for the Jonesboro Campus. Minister Gloria also served as administrative assistant at both campuses, Paracletos counselor, and a Life Coach.
