This man of God started out on his Christian journey early in life. He was set out to do the will of his Lord and Savior.

Pastor Henry Robert Wright, Jr. was baptized at the Cleveland Chapel Methodist Church as a young child. He later became a member of the Wardell United Methodist Church, being monitored by his father Henry, Sr. to do God will without wavering and then to Macedonia Baptist Church in Riverdale, Georgia. After serving as a deacon for many years he was called to the ministry but didn't want to believe the calling on his life. But surrendering his

life and the call by the Almighty God, in 1971 Henry was licensed as a minister of the Gospel, he provided Christian advice to couples preparing for marriage, provided service to a countless number of children, or those simply seeking understanding of God's Word. He welcomed and was grateful for the opportunity to stand before the congregation to share the Word of God. Our dad believed EVERY word written in the Bible and was committed to sharing it with others. Pastor Wright loved to minister and testify about the goodness of the Lord! It only took ONE scripture to get him started and once he got started there was no limit to how long he could go. The question then became "How much time do you have"?

He went on to Co-Pastor the Mt. Carmel Baptist Church in McDonough, Georgia from 1971-1975. Thereafter he became Pastor of the Liberty Spring Baptist Church in Griffin, Ga for number of years. But, in 1976, while pastoring at both churches, Pastor Wright was lead to Mt. Pleasant to become the senior pastor. Preaching and teaching God's word for over thirty years. Through Pastor Wright leadership and direction Mt. Pleasant has grown physically and spiritually. After retiring in 2005, he passed the torch to Pastor James Smith of Barnesville, Georgia.

Henry worked for Delta Airlines, Inc. for thirty-one years. He begin this journey on May 26, 1960 and retired on June 1, 1991. He received many honorary certificates from Delta Airlines. 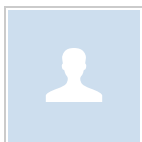
