Ms. Carmichael was a wonderful coworker and friend. We worked together at the USPS. I met her while I was on a detail. She was working with stamps and I was working on the route examination team. A casual conversation in passing led to us working together on a new project. I asked if we could allow people to respond to Santa letters and she took it to management. Media ran the story and we were bombarded with gifts from kind strangers fulfilling requests from children all over DC. For those who didn't pick up their gifts, we went out and delivered the presents. The following year, she got in touch with me to do the Santa letters again, and added a coworker to the team. We delivered literally hundreds of gifts to children all over DC, in a postal RV. That was my last year working with her, as I didn't get to go the following year, and shortly after that, left the USPS. I never forgot about her, as our birthdays were in such close proximity. Ms. Carmichael lived her life as we all should strive to live. She was pleasant, humble, loving, caring, and committed to whatever she was attached to. She's gone from our presence but will remain in my thoughts and heart.
