Lillian Serethea Brown was born at Greenville, South Carolina on January 17, 1927 to

Triphenia Harvey and Richard Pasley. She was the fourth oldest of four children.

Lillian, at about three years of age was relocated from South Carolina to (Harlem)

Manhattan, New York where she lived until relocating to Brooklyn, New York.

On August 6, 1938, Lillian was Baptized at Mt. Zion Baptist Church, 1807 Bath Avenue,

Brooklyn, New York by the late Reverend Samuel L. Arrington.

Lillian subsequently graduated on January 25, 1945, from Brooklyn High School of

Women's Garment Trades earning a diploma in Garment Machine Operations a trade in

which she worked for many years. In 1976, she earned a Bachelor of Arts Degree from

Wagner College at Staten Island, New York and then pursued a 20 years long career in

education as a para-professional with the Board of Education, City of New York, NY.

At the age of 19 and on June 1, 1946, Lillian married the late Curtis Leonard Brown. The ceremony was performed by Reverend Samuel L. Anington at Mt. Zion Baptist Church, Brooklyn, NY with witnesses Mrs. Willie Mae Andrews and Mrs. Dora Brown in attendance. This union gave life to Lillian and Curtis' only child, a daughter, Lois Maria Brown. In life, however, Lillian also raised her brother William Pasley's daughter, Bernadette Pasley. Lillian, at the age of 91 went home to our Lord in her sleep at Stockbridge, Georgia on April 107, 2018. Lillian was preceded in death by siblings William, Gladys and Walter Pasley.
