



Rev. Dr. Morgan McCampbell Jr.

March 10, 1947 - December 19, 2021

Morgan McCampbell, Jr. a.k.a. “Fella Man” was born on March 10, 1947 to Morgan McCampbell, Sr. (deceased) and Ethel Bell Archie McCampbell (deceased) in Safford, AL. Morgan Jr. leaves to foster his memory, a devoted and dedicated wife of 53 years, Gladys West McCampbell. Within this union, 3 children were born: Yolanda Renée (Daniel), McDonough, GA, Chelsia Mortrece, McDonough, GA. Preceded in death, Morgan III. One granddaughter, Morgan NaKya Coleman, McDonough, GA. Rev. McCampbell was extremely ambitious and outgoing. He accepted Christ at a very young age. As a teenager, Morgan preached his first sermon and later became an ordained minister. He served the Lord as a Pastor in the A.M.E. Zion denomination at numerous churches. Rev. McCampbell also served honorably on the Episcopal Committee for many years. This is the committee that elects Bishops. His commitment has always been to God and the flock. In many situations, he was assigned to stagnant undeveloped churches. His motto was to teach Christians to “do” and not just “sit”.
