Polly became the first black women to work for the Chicago Board of Education in 1986 as an Interior Designer for the public-school system. Polly dedicated her life to Christ whole heartily, she was saved sanctified and baptized with the holy ghost in 1982. Under the leadership of Bishop RL Mitchell of Old Land Mark Church Holiness in Christ in Chicago IL, she was a faithful member until she moved to Georgia in 1997. Ms. Triche' was led by God to begin her missionary work by preaching and teaching at various Holiness Churches in Georgia. In 2010 Ms. Triche' became an ordained Pastor of True Holiness Church in Lake City, Ga. She was known as Pastor Polly to her members and friends. Before calling her home, she was a member of Mt. Zion Deliverance Temple in McDonough, Georgia lead by

Pastor Mario Hubbard.
