Mr. Steve Crews, Jr. was the son of the late Mr. Steve Crews, Sr. and Daisy Brown Crews. He was born on August 4, 1936 in Atlanta, Georgia. He departed this life on October 31, 2016 in Jonesboro, Georgia.

He attended the Atlanta Public School System and graduated from H. M. Turner High School. He continued his education at Clark Atlanta University. Shortly after college he joined the U.S. Air Force and served for 4 years. After leaving the Air Force he came home for about a year and then he joined the U.S. Army, where he served for 30 years.

He led several platoon missions in Vietnam and there he earned the title, "Cold Steel Crews". My father knew that the unseen hand of God protected him and his men on every dangerous mission. Several years later because of his outstanding military achievements, Steve quickly earned the title "Top Crews".
