She spent her early childhood in Louisiana until her family relocated to Jonesboro, Georgia in 1993. She graduated from Eagles Landing High School (Stockbridge, Ga.) and went on to graduate from Georgia Southern University (Statesboro, Ga.) where she received a degree in Sociology. Her career spanned as a retail associate at TJMaxx corporation; and then to Emory University (Decatur, Ga.) as a Coordinator in the Student Services Department for over 10 years.

Victoria volunteered for several years annually with Anime Weekend Atlanta. She participated in the Atlanta Japanese Fashion Community meets ups where she developed her interest and love for designing and creating Japanese fashion. She bridged her design interest into the entrepreneurial business Peachy Queen. Peachy Queen evolved from a successful online business to her participating as a vendor at several events over the years locally in and around Atlanta, Georgia; also, Raleigh North Carolina. She took pride in her business and handcrafted all her jewelry. She would spend hours at a time working to prepare for her events.

In her spare time, she enjoyed spending time with her family and friends, gardening, video games, cosplay designing, reading novels, learning a new language-Korean, shopping, and traveling to the beach.

Victoria had a pivotal role as a caregiver for her mother; and helped to raise both her nephews Marcus and Joshua.

She is survived by her father Ronald S. Felder, sister Cletese E. Dijuste (Claude M. Dijuste), nephews Marcus C. Dijuste and Joshua A. Dijuste.; grandparents Walter Felder and Berdia Felder; and her extended family comprised of many uncles, aunts, and cousins.

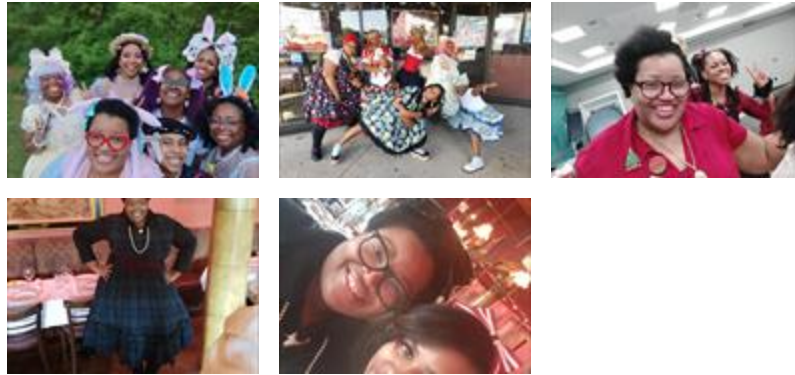
