



Wilbur Ringer Jr.

Mr. Wilbur Ringer, Jr. was born on October 10, 1936 to the late Wilbur, Sr. and Bertha Byrd Ringer. He departed this life on January 31, 2015 at the Sacred Journey Hospice in McDonough, Georgia.

He joined the New Macedonia Baptist Church at an early age and served on the Usher Board. At the age of 17, Wilbur enlisted in the U.S. Navy. He attended school in the Clayton County School System and in January, 1966, he received the his high school diploma while through the U.S. Navy accreditation program. At the age of 27, he was united in marriage to Lottie Wilson on April 9, 1963. The Lord blessed him with five children: Rosa Lynn, Gloria, Vonceil, Delroy and Tracy; eleven grandchildren and eight great grandchildren. Wilbur retired from the U.S. Navy on September 22, 1975 with the rank of E7 Chief Petty Officer. He worked at Gulf Port Oil in Louisiana and was the owner of two tractor trailer trucks – one of which he drove and the other he leased to other drivers.

Wilbur made his home in Jacksonville, Florida. He joined the Mt. Arratt Baptist Church in Jacksonville and faithfully served on the Usher Board until his health failed him in late 2014. Wilbur was blessed with a great church family and friends at Mt. Arratt Baptist Church.
